COMPETENCE AND CONFIDENCE PARTNERS IN POLICYMAKING (C2P2)

Free training programs for people with disabilities, family members and/or professionals. Participants commit to a series of 2-day sessions to learn policies and develop skills to lead.

The Institute offers two targeted C2P2 programs:



C2P2 Early Intervention

Families with an infant, toddler or pre-school age child a disability learn to advocate for themselves and others.



C2P2 Family Leadership in Inclusive Education for Non-Public Schools

Families of students who are educated at home, or in charter, cyber charter, private or parochial schools, receive leadership development training, guidance and technical assistance to help achieve true inclusion for their children.

Free information sessions on the basics of Early Intervention in the Philadelphia school system for families receiving Early Intervention services. Participants network with families and learn to be an effective member of the Early Intervention Team.
