for individuals who use augmentative and alternative  
communication (AAC) devices.

AAC users receive services and supports that culminate in 10 days of intensive instruction “in residence” at Temple University’s main campus, plus follow-along services.

- ✓ become a more effective communicator
  - Develop skills for using your AAC device
  - Customize your AAC device
  - Store and retrieve vocabulary
  - Develop/improve public speaking skills
  - Make more functional use of your AAC device
- ✓ become a more competent computer user
  - Interface your AAC device with a computer
  - Back up and transfer information
  - Learn word processing and other functions
  - Access the Internet
  - Participate in Augmentative Communication OnLine Users Group (ACOLUG)
- ✓ develop a vision and a plan for employment, post-secondary education and community living
