What is TDDP?

Pennsylvania's TDDP provides specialized equipment, without charge, to eligible Pennsylvanians who have disabilities that impede independent access to telephone services.

- Created through PA ACT 34-1995
- Implemented by Pennsylvania's Initiative on Assistive Technology, in conjunction with the PA Office of Vocational Rehabilitation and the PA Public Utilities Commission.

To be eligible, you must:

- Be a Pennsylvania resident with a disability or disabilities that prevent you from making and/or receiving phone calls independently
- Be six years of age or older
- Have individual gross income of 200% of the federal poverty level or less (low income)
- Have the ability to learn how to use the requested device(s)

**If you meet ALL of the above requirements,
you may be eligible for free equipment.**
