Individuals with intellectual disabilities spend four semesters on Temple University's main campus experiencing college life

AAL students

attend classes and explore career options based on their interests and goals

participate in the wide variety of activities available to all Temple students

are matched with a student mentor who supports the individual in accessing Temple University's many resources

AAL offers an authentic learning experience where students:

determine and direct the support they need

select their own course load according to their interests

are enrolled in a weekly seminar focusing on college life in addition to their academic courses

To be considered for the AAL, participants must:

be age 18-26

be able to pay for classes through service funds or privately

have transportation to Temple's main campus

be available to attend day and evening classes

participate in extracurricular activities
